Sewer Project Update I am sure most of you have noticed brightly colored stakes along Route 42 and Route 55. These “offset” stakes are reference points for the manholes and *do not* indicate where the sewer line will be going on your property. Once the manholes are in place the stakes will be removed. It is anticipated that construction of the sewer extension will begin sometime in early May.

Spring Clean-Up Spring clean-up for the Town of Neversink will take place on April 25th, 28th, May 2nd and 5th. Each permit holder is allowed to dispose of three pick-up loads. Televisions and other electronic equipment are *not* included in the clean-up. Regular disposal fees will apply for those items – so please keep separate. Tires, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers and air conditioners *will not* be accepted during this time. This program is made possible by the Sullivan County Legislature.

Tire Amnesty Program Sullivan County residents may deposit up to four (4) tires per person at no charge between April 21-28, 2007. Residents may bring the tires to the Sullivan County Landfill or the Ferndale, Highland, Mamakating, Rockland or Cochection solid waste facilities. Proof of residency (i.e. paid tax bill) and a valid photo ID is required.
