Sewer Project Update Construction has come to a close for the winter with the project ahead of schedule. As soon as the weather breaks in the spring, the construction crews will be out again in full force.

Tax Collector Lisa Garigliano, Tax Collector, will collect taxes Monday thru Friday from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM at the Town Hall; and on Saturday, 1/26/08 from 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM at the Town Hall. Payments can also be mailed by sending entire tax bill with payment to Lisa Garigliano, Tax Collector, PO Box 307, Grahamsville, NY 12740. Lisa will also issue transfer station permits on 1/26 to those who cannot get to the Town Hall during normal business hours.

Transfer Station I am pleased to let everyone know that the long awaited “mixed paper” container has arrived at the transfer station. Acceptable “mixed paper” items are: magazines, “junk” mail, telephone books, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, TV dinner cartons, envelopes, books with hard covers removed, gray note pad backer board, papers towel tubes, school and office paper. There are a few changes in the fee schedule for bulky items and tires effective January 1, 2008. A copy of the list is available in the Town Clerk’s office and the transfer station.

Sullivan County Transportation I would like to make everyone aware of the Mobility Management program Sullivan County offers.
